Future Skills and New Jobs in the Green Sector

Labour Market Information Update

Across East Sussex, sectors associated with net zero are likely to grow three times as fast as overall employment, esp. environmental



conservation and professional / consulting sectors (inc. sustainability roles such as water or flood management).

- •Our local construction sector recognises its role in the transition to net zero and will be upskilling and training employees. The Contruiction Industry Training Board (CITB) estimates that the green transformation of buildings will lead to an extra 200,000 full-time equivalent workers by 2030, with this rising to 250,000 from the mid-2030s to mid-2040s and that the key drivers will be heat pump installation, retrofitting, efficiency, heating, ventilation, air conditioning and general electrical and construction trades.
- •In the landbased sector, businesses considered that job growth and skills needs will relate to new production methods, sustainable land management, and more efficient technologies that prevent waste, with climate change in East Sussex offering opportunities in wine making (viticulture) as well as threats, and policy changes leading to carbon offsetting and biodiversity requirements in planning policy which will have implications for increased jobs in forestry and natural resource management.









Future Skills and New Jobs in the Green Sector





- •In the automotive sector, there is a key training need for staff in terms of working with/on electric vehicles, electric vehicle charging installation and upskilling and replacing leavers with new entrants will happen rather than growth.
- •In the health and social care sector, a focus on sustainability will mean that new entrants and existing staff will need the skills to be able to use online and digital platforms instead of a reliance on paperbased systems and adapt to the shifts from homecare to online medicare provision.
- •BEIS and DESNZ predict up to 50,000 jobs by 2030 in hydrogen and nuclear power, Carbon capture and storage.
- •Natural England more than 20,000 new jobs over the next decade in environment conservation/biodiversity - including flood defences, tree planting and re-wilding.


