### Welcome

Twilight Activities are optional and will be on a first-come, first-served basis. - Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022: Twilight Activities commence.
- Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2022: Twilight Activities finish.

Please note: Twilight Activities will not be taking place on days when a Secondary / Sixth Form Parents' Evening is scheduled. Parents will receive advance notification of these dates.

- 1. **TEAM MATHS CHALLENGE: YEARS 7-9** 

Cost: £10.00 per term Max: 30 students

Do you enjoy solving problems? Is Maths one of your favourite subjects? Why not join the Gildredge House UKMT Team Challenge - practice Maths Team challenge events in preparation for events throughout the year.

GILDREDGE HOUSE NEWSPAPER: YEARS 7-10

Cost: £10.00 per term Max: 20 students

Do you have an interest in journalism? Would you like to create a newspaper for your peers to read every term? In this Twilight Activity, you will have a role in the newspaper production; it will be your job to research and create a piece to include in the termly Gildredge Gazette. This is a great activity for those students who enjoy writing, are frequent readers and who can voice their opinions.

**CREATING A PODCAST: YEARS 7-10** 

Cost: £10.00 per term Max: 30 students

This 10-week programme will introduce you to the elements of podcasting; storytelling, interviewing, production and editing on podcasting software. We will also have an award-winning podcaster in school to give a presentation. You will be part of creating a series of Gildredge House podcasts to share with our community. Come and lend your ideas, imagination and voice to the first Gildredge House Podcast.

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE: YEARS 9-11

Cost: £10.00 per term Max: 20 students

We will be putting on a performance of a scripted play in December. Come along to join rehearsals and be part of the cast or crew.

**CREATIVES: YEARS 7-10** 

Cost: £20.00 per term Max: 15 students

A master class in Mosaics and Applied glass panels: Ever wondered how Gaudi created his mosaics at Park Guell, or how the Romans created their elaborate mosaic floors? The first part of these workshops will show you how to create a design to be produced as a mosaic panel. The second part of these workshops will show you how you can use similar techniques to create a mosaic panel made out of glass that you can use as a light catcher. There will be small charge for these workshops for the resources you are using.

**HOMEWORK CLUB: YEARS 7-9** 

Cost: FREE

**ASTRONOMY: YEARS 7-10** 

Cost: £20.00 per term Max: 20 Students

Astronomy Club will look at all things space... This will include image taking of stellar objects using the Faulkes Telescope in Hawaii and Australia and learning how we process data to analyse images. We will look at terraforming other planets to support life. We will also look at Biology in space, such as the effects on the human body in zero gravity and how plants might grow. We will investigate the exciting experiments that happen on the International Space Station.

HISTORY FILM REVIEW: YEARS 7-9

Cost: £10.00 per term Max: 30 students

History Film Club allows students to learn about different aspects of the past, and assess the accuracy of how these events have been interpreted in film. Each term, students will learn about a particular event, watch a film about the event and then compare the film version to the reality. Students will end the term by writing up a film review/recommendation, and perhaps even have the opportunity to write their own alternative film scripts.

**GLOBAL PERSPECTIVES: YEARS 7-10**

Are you interested in current affairs and how they relate to the geography of a country. Each week, we will look at different countries and explore how their geography has influenced their development.
