At Bayernwald we visited the reconstructed trenches and learned about the medical problems and preventative measures used by soldiers. We then visited the fascinating hospital classroom at the Hooge Crater museum for a demonstration of the chain of evacuation and triage system at the Advanced Dressing Stations. Next came a walk into the town centre of Ypres and a visit to the much-anticipated chocolate shop, before finishing our trip at Lijssenthoek Military Cemetary and laying a wreath on behalf of Gildredge House.

At all points the students were polite, respectful and enthusiastic. Despite the extremely long day, students maintained high morale and energy throughout and were a real credit to the school.

Year 11


The students of Gildredge House have requested on many occasions that they have a sport kit primarily for when playing away fixtures in order to better represent the school.


