

Year 6 Safety in Action – Winners!



A few weeks ago, Year Six participated in a 'Safety in Action' workshop at the Sussex Downs College. It consisted of eight activities which helped educate and teach us important lessons about keeping ourselves and others around us safe.

Going around the various activities, we were tasked to work as accurately and efficiently as possible, earning points. These points were collectively added up and the aim was to earn more points than the other schools that attended.

Volunteers from the East Sussex Fire Brigade taught us valuable lessons such as: Railway safety; safe drinking; water safety; online safety, road crossing; CPR; dangerous litter and electrical safety. Every lesson was interactive and had different tasks and challenges Year Six had to complete and explain.



At the end, each child claimed a safety in action handbook and a certificate to celebrate their achievements. As well as that, they also earned the most points in their activities, which was rewarded with a certificate during Monday's KS2 assembly.

The workshop has given us an opportunity to experience life-like situations and showed us what it means to keep ourselves (as well as others) safe in our ever-growing world.


Michael and Lucy read extracts of their books and did a Q&A with some of the children in the crowd. They inspired us so much.

WELCOME TO OUR NEW OCEAN THEMED SENSORY ROOM IN THE OASIS CENTRE!

The new sensory room is a multi-sensory environment designed to provide support for our students with SEND as well as helping individuals develop and regulate their emotions. Students will discover a range of equipment including coloured liquid floor tiles, a large memory foam mat and several bean bags providing different tactile experiences.

Hanging waterfall lights, an underwater projector and other mood lighting items have also been acquired to deliver a calming and soft atmosphere for students to relax in.





Students who require a more palpable experience will find a box of fidget objects to regain concentration and their emotions, whilst our new fish bubble lamp helps to calm the senses.



We can't wait for our students to enjoy the full benefits of the new Sensory Room.
